

- 1. Roleplay a friend asking you to articulate the core message of the Gospel. What are the essential parts of the Good News? Why must they be included in the message?
- 2. What 2 or 3 scriptures from the Bible would support your personal Gospel presentation.
- 3. Practice again the same personal presentation ensuring that it is devoid of any church language or confusing theological terms/phrases that an unchurched, unbeliever might struggle to understand. Make the presentation plainly clear in plain, kind language.
- 4. Elaborate on what it means to repent. Spend time in personal repentance together as a group.
- 5. What does it mean to Follow Jesus? How is this different from causal, American church attendance. What is the Biblical standard described of following Jesus? (Gal 2:20, Eph 5: 1 & 2, other?)
