- 2. The value of people is another major theme in Amos. People are not things; people matter more than things. "We cannot be right with God and wrong with man. We cannot be right with God unless what He is to us provides the pattern to what we are to others." Discuss.
- 3. The evidence of our relationship with God is in how we treat our neighbor. What damage is done when we get this wrong?
- 4. Bethel, Gilgal and Beersheba were all places of great spiritual significance for God's people, but they had become a stench to God. Why? Is there any comparison in the church today or in you today? It seems spiritual and right, but God is not pleased...
- 5. An additional major theme in Amos is righteousness and justice. Read Amos 5: 21 24. What does an expression of justice look like in your daily life?
