2. Should Christians never judge others? When is it necessary to judge? What does it mean to 'judge' correctly? When are we not called to judge as Christians?

3. Read Matthew 7:3-5. What is the speck of sawdust and the plank in the eye referring to? Have you ever been on the receiving end or the giving end of bad judgement?

4. What is the meaning of verse 6 and how is it related to the rest of the passage?

5. What/who do the dogs and pigs refer to? How would you describe the character of these kinds of people? What is sacred?
