- 2. Read 1 Corinthians 13 and talk about the quality, expectation and standard of love that God calls us toward? Where do you need to take responsibility, where do you need to grow and mature?
- 3. The sermon addressed the idea of loving the unlovable/stranger with humility. Expound on this idea and what that might look like for you. Also reflect on how this mirrors the way in which Christ has brought His love to you.
- 4. If you could set up a confessional booth for non-Christians to step into... And if you could confess our lack of love to a non-Christian, how would you convey that on behalf of the church at large and for yourself, personally? What do you think such a confession would accomplish?
- 5. "The supreme religious challenge is to see God's image in one who is not in our image" Discuss and pray together for people in your lives that need Christ and your loving witness.
