- 2. How do the above passages speak to about the coming of Jesus as our Good Shepherd?
- 3. Jesus has made several claims to His own divinity throughout the entirety of John 10. As a group, can you identify them? (Start with the two different 'I Am' statements)
- 4. If Jesus isn't just a shepherd but is indeed our Good Shepherd, what does that change in how you interact with Him?
  - -Does it change the way you should worship Him?
  - -Does it change the way you think about Him?
  - -Do you have full trust in Him?
- 5. Spend some time as a group praying specifically prayers of thankfulness and adoration for the sacrifice of the Good Shepherd and for the way He leads and loves you.
