

- 1. Where are you most tempted to choose "cozy" over "Christlike"? What would it look like for you to "deny yourself, take up your cross, and follow Him" (Luke 9:23) in that area this week?
- 2. Defining 'Good' How has God used an uncomfortable or painful season to shape you more into His likeness?
- 3. "The comfort zone is where dreams go to die." What kind of resistance or discomfort might God be inviting you to stop avoiding right now?
- 4. "If I had pulled Joseph out, I would have cheated nations out of the one God would use to deliver them." Sometimes, we'd rather rescue! Think about someone in your life who's struggling. How can you walk with them faithfully without trying to remove the pain God might be using to form them?
- 5. "Even in This..." What is your "this" right now that thing you wish would just go away? How can you practically invite God to use it to make you more like His Son?
