1. Judges 16:20 says, “But he did not know that the Lord had left him.” What stands out to you about Samson’s lack of awareness, and why do you think it’s possible for someone to drift spiritually without realizing it?
2. Samson had real strength and calling, but very little self-control or accountability. Where do you see that tension showing up in your own life—or in men you know?
3. The sermon emphasized that isolation is one of the enemy’s most effective strategies against men. In what ways do you see isolation, withdrawal, or distraction showing up in your own rhythms or relationships?
4. The message gave four very practical invitations: watching for subtle grooming by the enemy, taking dominion and responsibility, pursuing real relationships, and choosing a gentlemanly way of life. Which one of those do you feel most challenged by right now, and what would a specific, concrete step look like for you this week or this season?
5. As the remainder of the series addresses, parenting, women, marriage and eventually foster/adoption, who do you know that could be invited into an upcoming week?
