

# REVELATION – wk.2 | GROUP CONTENT

## SERMON QUESTIONS:

**Ice Breaker:** What's the best advice you've ever gotten?

- 1. Meeting Jesus** – John encounters Jesus in a moment of isolation and suffering on Patmos – where do you currently feel cut off, weary, or limited, and how does this vision of Jesus meet you there?
- 2. Describing Jesus** – This chapter reveals multiple attributes of Jesus (Ancient of Days, Alpha and Omega, refining fire, unshakable foundation, sovereign King)—which description most challenges or comforts you right now, and why?
- 3. Feet of Jesus** – John falls at Jesus' feet in awe and fear, yet Jesus responds with a touch and the words, “Do not be afraid”—what does that tension between holiness and closeness stir in you personally?
- 4. Authority of Jesus** – The sermon emphasized that Jesus alone carries true authority—whose words or voices tend to carry the most weight in your life, and what would it look like to place Jesus' words above them?
- 5. Faith in Jesus** – Jesus tells John to keep going, to write, and to stay faithful even late in life and under pressure—what does faithfulness look like for you in this season, especially if God doesn't remove you from your “Patmos” right away?

**“I Will” STATEMENT:** An ‘I Will’ Statement is where we respond to what we discussed by making a simple commitment to an action we can complete in the next week. It is a deliberate commitment to practically obey the Word of God and listen to the Holy Spirit. Share what you feel like God may be calling you to do.

**PRAYER:** Take time to ask each person how the group can be praying for them during the next week. Take notes so you can follow up. If this is your first meeting, plan to be the one to pray out loud for the group. As the group continues, pay attention to everyone's comfort level with praying out loud before inviting others to do so. No one should feel pressured, but should be encouraged.
