

REVELATION – wk.1 | GROUP CONTENT

SERMON QUESTIONS:

Ice Breaker: What's something you want to learn in this series?

1. **The Center Of It All** – Revelation opens by naming Jesus as the center of the story—how does that shift the way you approach uncertainty, suffering, or the future right now?
2. **Under Pressure** – The sermon described Revelation as encouragement for “small churches under pressure”—where do you personally feel pressure, fatigue, or opposition in your faith journey?
3. **Images** – John uses vivid images (Lion, Lamb, sword, numbers) to communicate truth—what image from today's message lingered with you, and what truth about Jesus did it communicate?
4. **True Authority** – The sermon emphasized that Jesus alone carries true authority—whose words or voices tend to carry the most weight in your life, and what would it look like to place Jesus' words above them?
5. **Full of Faith** – Instead of speculating about the end times, Jesus calls His people to be spiritually awake and faithful—what does faithfulness look like for you in this summer?

“I Will” STATEMENT: An ‘I Will’ Statement is where we respond to what we discussed by making a simple commitment to an action we can complete in the next week. It is a deliberate commitment to practically obey the Word of God and listen to the Holy Spirit. Share what you feel like God may be calling you to do.

PRAYER: Take time to ask each person how the group can be praying for them during the next week. Take notes so you can follow up. If this is your first meeting, plan to be the one to pray out loud for the group. As the group continues, pay attention to everyone's comfort level with praying out loud before inviting others to do so. No one should feel pressured, but should be encouraged.
