1. Jesus said, "In this world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world." What kinds of trouble, disappointment, or suffering are you currently facing, and how does Jesus' promise speak into that situation?
2. The sermon highlighted Christians around the world who face persecution for their faith. What challenged, surprised, or impacted you most about their stories? How should their example shape the way we pray, live, or share our faith?
3. Revelation 7 presents a picture of God's people being known, counted, and sealed by Him. How does it encourage you to know that God sees every one of His children and that nothing can separate us from His care?
4. The message emphasized holding our interpretations with humility while holding tightly to Jesus. Why is humility important when Christians disagree about difficult passages of Scripture? How can we remain united around what is clear and essential?
5. The sermon ended with the example of believers who continued to worship even in suffering. What would it look like for you to trust, worship, and remain faithful to Christ in the middle of your own tribulation rather than waiting for circumstances to improve?
