1. Revelation 12 paints a vivid picture of a spiritual battle between good and evil. Where do you personally feel the tension of that battle showing up in your life right now?
2. One of the primary strategies of the enemy is deception. What are some lies that sound convincing in our culture today, and how can you train yourself to pause and ask, “Is this true?” before believing or acting on them?
3. John describes intense pressure and intimidation to conform. Where do you feel pressure to stay silent, blend in, or compromise your faith, and what would it look like to pre-decide faithfulness in that area?
4. The enemy is also called the accuser, constantly reminding people of their failures. When you hear accusing thoughts, how can you respond with the truth of the Gospel and the reality of what Christ has done for you?
5. Revelation reminds us that the enemy’s time is short and that victory comes through the blood of the Lamb and the word of our testimony. Where is God inviting you to actively resist darkness and live out your faith with courage this week?
