11. Revelation 15 shows people praising God by saying, “Just and true are your ways.” Why do you think God’s judgment leads to worship in this moment, and what does that reveal about His character?
2. The message highlights that every person has a deep desire for justice. Where do you feel that longing most strongly in your own life, and how have you typically responded when something feels unfair?
3. Because God is the only perfectly just judge, we are called to release a spirit of vengeance. Is there a situation or person in your life where you need to let go of judgment and trust God to handle it? What would that actually look like for you?
4. Scripture teaches that nothing is hidden and that every part of our lives will be brought into the light. How does that truth challenge the way you think about secrecy, confession, and living honestly in community?
5. The message describes two “books,” our works and the book of life. How does knowing that your name is written in the book of life through Christ shape your confidence, your humility, and the way you live today?
